- Laying of new tactile paving
- Supply & install of new LED Belisha Beacons.
- Supply & install new pedestrian guardrails
- Line marking of the crossing and approach markings
- Traffic & pedestrian signage
- Landscaping of the adjacent area with new planting and bark mulch
- Temporary traffic management including temporary traffic lights and a signal-controlled crossing.
